



THAILAND [MAY 2022] - WHAT TO EXPECT, AND WHEN TO EXPECT IT:

DATE	WHAT HAPPENS
Early January	Resumes & Intro Videos sent to MK
Early January	Welcome pack emails sent to applicants
Must be valid within 6 months of May, can use DBS or Disclosure Scotland if from the UK	Apply for criminal record
6 Feb latest	<p>Must have Original Degree + Transcripts + Criminal Record Check + TEFL paper copy. These documents are sent to MK by email and they begin the VISA process for your application, on the Thai side. The docs don't need to be legalised for this.</p> <p>Passport needs at least 6 months validity <u>from</u> May.</p>
Prior to departure	Must have Degree legalised (transcripts don't get legalised)
Late January / February before the 6th	Placement calls with MK
By 9 th February	Placement is finalised
Between March and April (Usually about 6-8 weeks from teacher submitting documents to MK)	Apply for & Receive VISA (all done online, no need to go to Thai Embassy in person)
Mid April LATEST	Flight to Thailand
Mid April LATEST	1 week quarantine (unless this has got axed as a requirement by then)
Last week of April LATEST	1 Day MK Office induction



COSTS - This is a rough guide. Everything is subject to slight variation & potential change, not least due to Covid-19

<u>What For</u>	<u>£</u>	<u>When</u>
1 st half support fee	349	Upon signing up
Legalising Degree	160	At any point before departure
VISA	60	Early April
Vaccinations	Anywhere from 0-600 (depending what you get and where you get it)	In the couple months before departure
2 nd half support fee	350	Upon receiving job offer
Flight(s)	Anywhere from 400-900 (depending if single or return)	About 10 days before departure
Travel Insurance	Anywhere from 0-500	About 10 days before departure
Quarantine	300-700 (Depending if Phuket Sandbox or Bangkok hotel, also depending on duration at the time)	April
Covid Test	100	Week of departure
Initial Spending Money	Optional, but 500 is recommended	On arrival
